Changes keep coming at Casa del Mar....

The goals and visions that the Board of Directors set forth 3-4 years ago are beginning to be realized. It is sometimes hard to fathom that a project can take 3-4 years to complete but when you realize that all projects need to be planned, designed, approved, bid, financed and then executed then it does not seem so unreasonable. Add to that the fact that until recently bringing forth large projects to members for approval could only happen during the June convocation.

Those members who have visited the resort recently have seen the progress on the renovation of the building exterior. While this project was primarily a repair of the exterior panels, the stucco finish is giving Casa del Mar a new fresh look and members who have seen it love it. The pool-side and Ocean-front sections are done and the contractor is approximately halfway finished with the Divi side. The front of the building will take quite a while due to the fact that they need to renovate the interior corridor as well as the exterior surfaces and due to the extensive damage on that side of the building.

The furniture and appliance projects are also nearing completion. The majority of the appliances have arrived and have been installed in the suites. The sofas and loveseats as well as the artwork and dining room mirrors have all arrived and been installed. This week the first 4 of 18 forty-foot containers arrived from China. These 18 containers contain the remainder of the furniture for the suites and will arrive at the rate of 3-4 per week over the next 5 weeks. The logistics of unloading, staging and setting the furniture, as well as removing the old furniture and selling it will be quite a challenge. We are hoping that by September all of the furniture and appliances will be installed in the suites. The only items that may not be installed by September are the ceiling fans, dining table lights and the draperies. These items will be installed as we can get into unoccupied rooms.

The last project is the renovation of the suite interiors and bathrooms. As this project requires design and architectural drawings as well as hiring contractors it has taken a bit longer to execute. The Board of Directors has approved the final design of the Ambassador bathrooms and these designs are being shown to members for the first time in this newsletter on pages 11, 12 and 13. The next step will be for the architect to draw up the scope of the renovations and complete the mechanical, electrical and plumbing (MEP) drawings. In order to do this, we will be constructing a model bathroom in one of the Ambassador suites. Once all of this is done, we will send the specs out to contractors to bid the job and based on their input on how many suites they can renovate at a time and how long they will take, we will begin the planning stage of the renovation. This same process will be repeated for the Presidential building. We are moving forward with the other facets of the interior renovations, however. We have installed the closet doors in the Ambassador suites and have ordered the interior doors and baseboard. We have also received the closet doors for the Presidential building and will begin installing them as suites become available.

Members arriving over the next few months will be treated to the new look of Casa del Mar and we think that members will be pleased with the results.




News from the Board of Directors



During the most recent Board Meeting several topics that affect Members were discussed. Below is a recap of those discussions.

- The Board of Directors are evaluating the results of the Smoking Survey. At this time there will be no changes to the existing smoking policy. Once a decision is made on a path forward, notification will be sent to all members and posted on the Casa del Mar website.
- The Board of Directors reviewed the existing transfer fee structure and decided to make it more affordable to transfer units. The existing fee was \$105 per week for immediate family members and \$350 per week for non-family members. The new rates are \$100 **per deed** (not per week) for immediate family members, \$200 **per deed** for member to member transfers and \$250 **per deed** for a transfer to or from a non-member. This change takes place immediately.
- Wifi rates will stay the same up to the 4-week rate of \$59.95. Newly added is the rate of \$5.00 per week for any weeks over 4 weeks.



Emergency Phone

We have recently installed two red emergency phones, one on the pool deck of the presidential building next to the water fountain, and the other on the side wall of Matthews's restaurant next to the new handicap ramp.

Three more will be installed. One on the pool deck of the Ambassador building, one at the garden side of the Presidential building near the BBQ grills and the third emergency phone location is still to be determined .

These phones are for emergency purposes only. A press on the button sends a message straight to the operator to a dedicated emergency number, informing them that there is an emergency. The operator will inform security immediately of the happenings, and the location.



Renovation Update

The CDM Renovation is progressing. The ocean front units are completed in the areas facing the water. One half of construction crew is working on the balconies of the units ending in #21, #19 and #17. Once those balconies are done the scaffolding will be moved to the front of the building. The #09 units have been finalized and the manlift crew is now working on the units ending in #11 and will progress their way down to the units ending in #17.

Beyond the exterior work there are various containers coming in soon with the remaining furniture and appliances to tie in the new look of your home away from home.



- Reinsulate chilled water lines Presidential building phase 1, 2nd floor.



Mind Your Code of Conduct When in Aruba

Tourism Authorities will start an awareness campaign after two pictures of visitors with their jeeps and UTV in the ocean went viral on social media. The pictures caused an online outrage for both visitors and locals. How could someone end up with a rental vehicle in the ocean, while it's not even allowed to drive on the beach sand?



The new awareness campaign will be implemented to reinforce the code of conduct for responsible traveling in Aruba. Both travelers and locals play an important role in developing responsible and sustainable tourism because they make a difference with their conduct and decisions.

If you did not know it yet, it's not allowed to drive on the beaches in Aruba. Planning on going off-roading with jeeps, UTV or ATV? Be careful where you drive on the north coast of the island. The terrain on this side are dry and rocky, but a lot of flora and fauna can be found here. Watch out not to drive over habitats belonging to lizards, iguanas, crabs, owls, rabbits and other small animals, even indigenous plants. The best way to discover the beauty of the northern coast without destroying nature is by joining guided tours. Locals who know the island can show you the way through Aruba's beauty. After the incidents with vehicles in the ocean by visitors, the government plans to fine drivers who choose to break the law. There are over 1000 ATV and UTV rentals on the island, can you imagine if everyone drives on the beach, rides over animal habitats or enter the ocean?

Everyone needs to respect nature in Aruba – locals and visitors alike.

Nature Conservation Projects in Aruba

Besides the beautiful beaches, Aruba is also a nature's lovers paradise. The national park of Aruba (Arikok) intends to keep the island a paradise for nature lovers by starting various nature conservation projects. Restoring the population of native parakeets called lora's & prikichis is one of their goals. The population on the island has decreased mainly due to building, habitat loss and invasive species like the boa constrictor snake. To prevent a decline in the shark population, investigations are also currently ongoing as to the amount of sharks in the islands deep blue waters. Sharks are not commonly found in the shores of Aruba, but most likely out in the deep blue, miles away from the beaches. A marine park will be implemented soon to protect flora, fauna and underwater life at different beach areas. The marine park will be effective at mangel halto and the surrounding bays. And at most of the beaches in San Nicolas, including Baby beach and Rodgers beach. Arikok national park will also start a restoration project for the mangroves at spaans lagoon. Including the planting new mangrove seeds in the area. A botanical garden will also be introduced in Aruba soon, with focus on medicinal plants.






